Day 5: Monday, October 29, 2012 Athens - Piraeus - Board Cruise Ship - Mykonos - Cruising

In the port of Piraeus, board your cruise ship for a memorable 4-night cruise of the Greek Islands and Turkey. While on board breakfast, lunch and dinner are included daily. **Cruise to Mykonos, the whitewashed jewel of the Cyclades Islands.** Hundreds of tiny chapels dot this island with its beautiful windmills. Don't miss Mykonos Town, where mazes of narrow streets link the whitewashed buildings. *Today breakfast, lunch and dinner will be included.*

Day 6: Tuesday, October 30, 2012 Kusadasi, Turkey - Patmos, Greece - Cruising

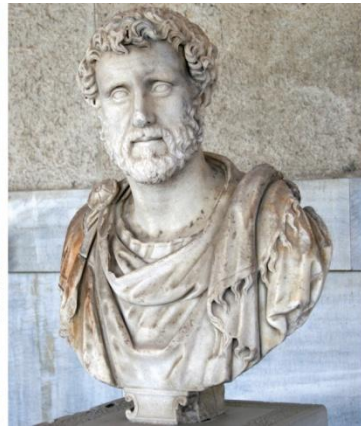
Arrive early this morning in the beautiful seaside resort of Kusadasi, Turkey. Perhaps enjoy an optional tour to the ruins of nearby Ephesus where you would see architectural masterpieces such as the great theatre, the baths, Hadrian's Temple, and the Library of Celsus before arriving at the Great Amphitheater. **Later, cruise to Patmos, an island of outstanding natural beauty, rocky hills, tranquil beaches, and many picturesque inlets. Today breakfast, lunch and dinner will be included.**

Day 7: Wednesday, October 31, 2012 Rhodes - Cruising

Enjoy a full day at leisure to explore Rhodes, known as the "Island of Roses." Walk the street of the Knights or see the superb collection of mosaics at The Grand Master's Palace. Optional shore excursions include Lindos, the island's gem, and one of the most important of the three great cities of ancient times with an acropolis dedicated to the goddess Athena. Set high on a hill 400 feet above the sea, on the brink of a precipice, Lindos is guarded by 13th century medieval walls. *Today breakfast, lunch and dinner will be included.*

Day 8: Thursday, November 01, 2012 Crete - Santorini - Cruising

Crete is the largest of the Greek islands and the mythological home of Zeus. You may choose an optional excursion to visit the Knossos excavations, the site of the ancient Minoan Kingdom dating back to 4000 B.C. when this great empire flourished on the island. **Later, arrive on the fabled island of Santorini, the most spectacular destination in the Mediterranean.** Enjoy leisure time to explore the fascinating landscape of vineyards, whitewashed chapels and volcanic cliffs or visit the nearby charming town of Oia. In Thira, the island's capital, white-washed houses, narrow streets, open-air cafes, and glittering



boutiques cling to steep cliffs, accessible by cable car or mule. *Today breakfast, lunch and dinner will be included.*

Piraeus (Athens) - Disembark Cruise Ship - Mycenae - Athens
 Bid farewell to the Greek Islands. **Cross the Corinth canal and travel to Mycenae, a**

Delphi

Delphi

After the Acropolis, Delphi is the most popular archaeological site in Greece, and the most popular day trip out of Athens. Built on the slopes of Mount Parnassos, overlooking the Gulf of Corinth and a valley filled with olive and cypress trees, the town and ancient site are as awe-inspiring now as it was three thousand years ago. In ancient times, Delphi was considered the centre of the known world, the place where heaven and earth met. This was the place on earth where man was closest to God. Delphi is known as the centre of worship for the God Apollo who symbolized moral discipline and spiritual clarity. The oracle of Delphi was a spiritual experience whereby kings, generals, and common folk asked the spirit of Apollo for advice on critical matters relating to people's lives or affairs of the state. During your visit, join a local expert in exploring the "The Sacred Way", the Temple of Apollo, the treasures and monuments that commemorate great events. See the 4th century theatre and the stadium which was famous for its chariot races and considered the best preserved in all of Greece. Tour the Museum of Delphi, one of the very best in all of Greece with its priceless treasures of ancient Greece, including the Omphalos (or navel of the earth) and the famous, well preserved bronze statue of the Charioteer of Delphi. The surrounding mountain views are spectacular. *Duration: Approximately 10 hours.* Please note a minimum of 15 passengers is required. Transportation is included.

Heraklion

Knossos Palace

Crete is the largest and the most rugged of the Greek Islands. It is also the home of the great Minoan Civilization and the mythological home of Zeus. After a short drive through the town of Heraklion the tour will arrive at the Knossos excavations. Here, Sir Arthur Evans's archaeological discoveries revealed a civilization dating back to 4000 B.C., when a great empire flourished on the island of Crete. Based on the wealth of artifacts that were found, Evans theorized that this was the site of the ancient Minoan Kingdom. These findings will be viewed in detail as your guide leads you on a journey of discovery through the sophisticated culture that flourished thousands of years ago on this island. The Palace, decorated with frescoes and shields, houses the Hall of the Royal Guard, the Hall of the Double Axes, the King's Chamber with the alabaster throne, the Queen's Apartment, beautiful courtyards and shrines. After visiting this remarkable site your coaches will take you back to the Venetian lion-guarded port of Heraklion to rejoin your ship. *Duration: Approximately 3.5 hours.* Transportation is included.

Ancient Ephesus**\$96 CAD**

Drive along the coast to reach Ephesus, famous in antiquity for its Temple of Diana - one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World - and later the home of St. John. During the years of the Roman Empire, the Greek port of Ephesus became the greatest city in Asia Minor. Upon arrival at Ephesus follow your guide to enter the ancient site through the Magnesian Gate. Discover innumerable monuments including the Forum, the Odeon, the Library of Celsus, the Thermal Baths of Scolastika and the Great Theatre built in the Greek era and reconstructed in the Roman period, which is still noted for its remarkable acoustics. View the symbols all around and marvel at the fact that one is still able to read the inscriptions in the ancient Greek language. Walk back to your coach along the Arcadian Way, where once Mark Anthony and Cleopatra rode in procession. As you drive back to Kusadasi, on a hill above Selcuk, just outside Ephesus, view the Basilica of St. John, which was erected over his grave in the 6th century A.D. by Emperor Justinian. Before returning to the ship, enjoy free time in Kusadasi or get a cultural taste of Turkey by enjoying an exhibition of oriental carpets, jewellery or leather goods.

Patmos**St. John's Monastery & Grotto of the Apocalypse****\$85 CAD**

Depart from the port of Scala and enjoy a short drive to the village of Chora, where the Monastery of St. John is built within the walls of a strong fortification. As you walk uphill towards the entrance of the monastery, marvel at this magnificent structure, which was built 900 years ago. View the courtyard, the monks' dining room and the old bakery before you visit the main church noted for its outstanding frescoes and interior decoration. Next, visit the small museum where priceless ecclesiastical treasures, books, manuscripts, mosaics, icons, splendid medieval textiles, vestments, and jewellery are housed. Return to your motor coach and continue to the nearby Grotto of the Apocalypse and the Monastery of the Apocalypse above it. Walk down the steps to the Grotto of the Apocalypse. Here you will see the niches in the wall that mark the pillow and ledge used as a desk by the author of the Book of the Revelation and the crack in the rock made by the voice of God honouring the Holy Trinity. Afterwards, drive back to the port of Scala and enjoy some free time in this quaint and picturesque town.

Roundtrip transportation is included. Please Note: Tour not suitable for passengers with walking difficulties. This optional tour includes visits to religious sites where knees and shoulders must be covered. *Duration: Approximately 2.5 hours.* Transportation is included.

Rhodes**Rhodes & Lindos Combined****\$85 CAD**

Drive along the picturesque south-eastern coastline, dotted with white-washed villages, to Lindos, one of the most important of the three great cities of ancient times. See how this entire city is guarded by medieval walls which were constructed by the knights of St. John in the 13th century. Within them stands the ancient Acropolis of Lindos, on the brink of a precipice 400 feet above the sea. From the Acropolis, marvel at the breathtaking views covering the great expanse of the Aegean Sea and St. Paul's Bay, where the apostle cast anchor during his historic voyage to Ephesus. Proceed on foot uphill, to the great staircase leading from the Hellenistic Portico to the Acropolis and Temple of Athena. Should you wish to make your way up by mule, a fee must be paid to the local muleteer. After the guided tour of the Acropolis, enjoy some free time on your own in Lindos village before meeting up with your motor coach. Return to Rhodes city and enjoy a panoramic drive through the new part of the city before continuing to Mount Smith to see the ruins of ancient Rhodes, the Temple of Apollo and Diagoras Stadium. Afterwards your motor coach will drop you off at Porte d'Amboise, the start of the walking tour through the medieval city of Rhodes. Follow your guide through the northern part where once lived the knights and their attendants. View the Palace of the Knights, continue your walk down Chevaliers Road to the Marine Gate and return back to the ship. A short visit to a ceramic factory is included.

Round Trip transportation is included. Please Note: the journey from Rhodes to Lindos is approximately 50 minutes. Walking uphill to the Acropolis is not suitable for passengers with walking difficulties. *Duration: Approximately 5 hours.* Transportation is included.

Santorini**Excursion to Oia Village****\$90 CAD**

Driving along the road you will have the opportunity to admire the panoramic view of the Aegean Sea and the neighboring islands. A unique sight is the various layers of lava that can be seen on the face of the rock, each layer being another phase of the activity of the volcano. Built on the Caldera rim, Oia Village is an excellent example of Cycladic architecture. Explore the village walking along the cobblestoned streets lined with white washed houses with blue shutters where one gets the impression that they are a beautiful travel poster. Your coach will bring you back to the part of Athinios, where you will embark your tender boat. It will be possible to remain in Fira and reach the port by cable car. Passengers will have to purchase the ticket at the cable car station.

Duration: Approximately 3 hours. Transportation is included.
