7. Tell us about what steps you take to create a positive work environment. This includes strategies aimed at recognizing success, investing in employees, and ensuring open communication. **15 MARKS**



8. Describe the most difficult challenge your company has encountered and the strategies used to overcome this challenge. **15 MARKS**

9. Describe your involvement with the community. **10 MARKS**
